OCFC receives funding for outreach to uninsured residents... This past January, the Clinic

received a grant from the Virginia Association of Free and Charitable Clinics (VAFCC) specifically to provide outreach to residents who are uninsured and in need of health care! With funding, the Clinic initiated an outreach campaign to make sure residents know that health care is available at the Clinic. Postcards went out to low income households throughout the county, ads are running in the OC Review, OC Resource Guide, Lake Currents and the OC Magazine. You'll see a Clinic table at Resource fairs and other initiatives this summer. Most importantly though, OCFC will assure that quality healthcare is accessible to all low income residents in our community who are not able to afford insurance. We've had 95 new patients enroll since January!

seem a small matter to some, but it was a happy day for Gloria when she walked out enjoying the fine details of the day!! Also, we receive letters consist-



- 248 total new patients since July 1 including 95 new patients enrolled since January 2019.
- 2,051 prescriptions requested including free brand name, low –cost generics and supplies;
- 807 unduplicated Patients served as of 3rd Qtr 2019 and 3,520 visits by patients!
- OCFC provided Women's Health and Wellness Services, including mammograms, PAP screenings
- Mental Health Counseling and referrals
- OCFC does it's part as a Medicaid enrollment site in partnership with RRCSB.




