## Results and Stats

#### About us-


- We average about 80 patient appointments a week, this is on top of visits for medication pick -up, referral request, flu Shots, BP Checks, Cortisone injections and more;
- 4,187 prescriptions written last qtr. (last three months) including free brand name and low – cost generics and supplies;
- Patients are reminded of their appointments through our Electronic Health Records System (Athena);
- About 81% of patients are diagnosed with a chronic disease;
- Diabetes, Hypertension and Depression are our three most diagnosed diseases;
- Diabetic Supplies are one of our costliest direct patient expense
- On average, 30 new patients are enrolled per month. Since July 2019, we've enrolled 120 new patients
- About 85% of our patients work and are uninsured or underinsured.
