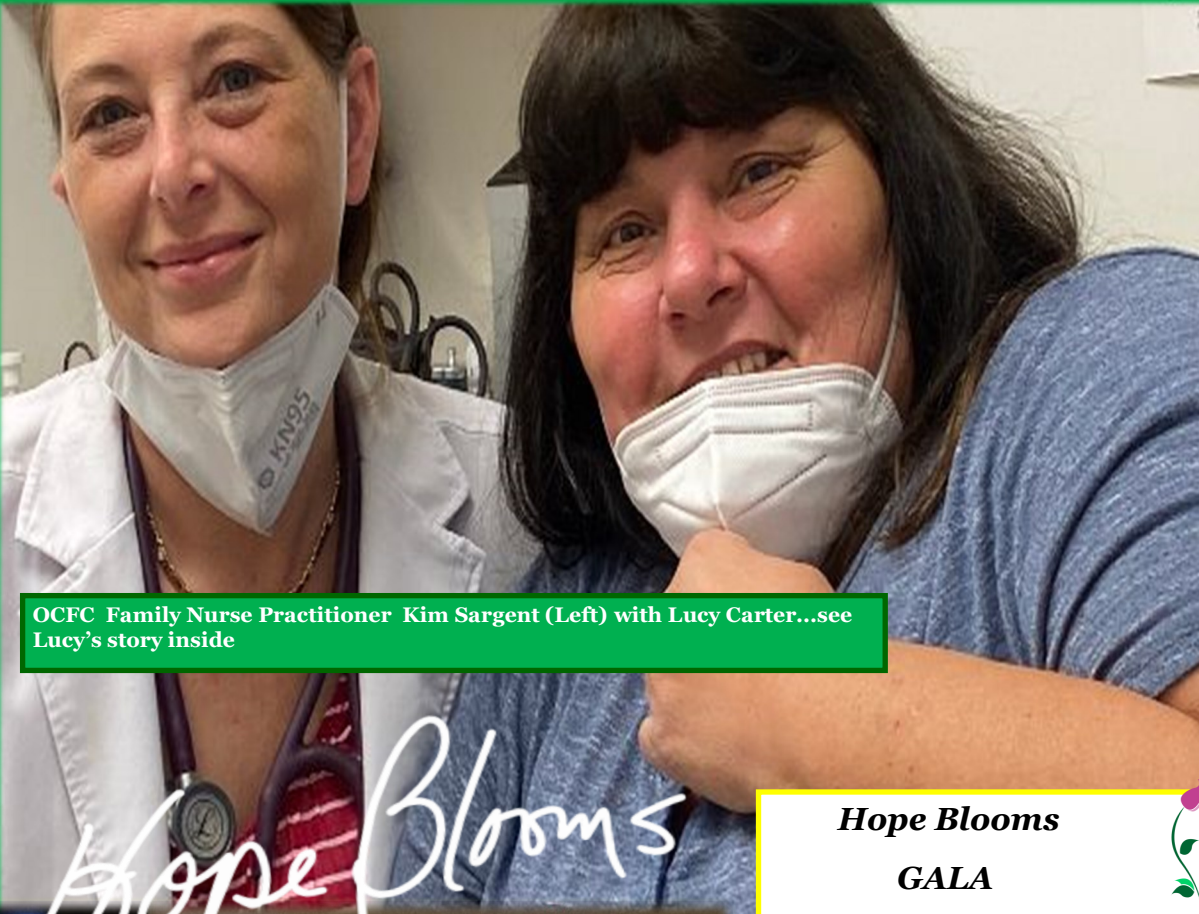

## Lucy's Story- Front Page

### **"When I say you saved my life...I mean it!"- Lucy (OCFC patient)**

...Boldly saying how the Clinic has helped her take control of her health and now enjoying a better quality of life since coming back to the Clinic. Like other residents, Lucy sought out the Clinic only after exhausting her own resources. The Orange County Free Clinic is a healthcare safety net available when needed.

Lucy said that she began seeing improvements in her health immediately after seeing NP Kim and NP Leslie at the OCFC. Her quality of life has improved and she's not hesitant to say that the Clinic saved her life!

Turns out, Lucy had undiagnosed "AFib" caused by uncontrolled hypertension and other issues making it difficult to breathe, walk, and unable to work consistently, literally causing her to miss out on life! She was put on proper medications, a healthcare regiment to help her manage her symptoms and said that now, the best part is hearing from her grandkids how much they love having her be a part of their daily activities!
