


who helps to support our patient medication assistance program . Working with major pharmaceutical companies, patients receive medications valued at over \$3.4 million annually!




Magie Zamora, CHW

Health Worker at Free Clinics to promote overall community health! This position is just one of the valuable resources available to residents who make the OCFC their primary healthcare home! Congratulations Magi!





It's a fact: Census information for Orange County (2022) shows 10% of the population are uninsured and underinsured...unaffordable even when working! It is not a situation that any of us want to be in... The Orange County Free Clinic is available to those in our community who need a primary healthcare home! **Outreach Postcards** (left) go out to residents and employers so they know how to find us! Outreach grant is from the VAFCC.

OCFC enrolled 218 new patients last year (July 22-June '23)

Thank you for supporting Clinic Efforts to provide services!

Sentara Health granted OCFC \$20,000 in August to support Mental Health counseling at the Clinic...helping to fill a gap in this critical need! Sentara MJH partners with OCFC to bring Colorectal FIT Screenings to patients and other services.

Mental Health: Helping patients live

their best lives... Recognizing that physical and emotional care are inextricably tied. Healthcare at the OCFC means addressing all of a persons' needs. **OCFC provides primary healthcare services to** over 750 patients in 5000 visits annually.

Patient Story: Faced with eviction, losing her job and losses during a divorce, "Ann Marie" asked to see the Clinics' Counselor to help sort things out. She also met with the Clinic's Nurse Practitioner for health concerns, and the Community Health Worker (CHW) for help finding a job. After several visits with her medical team, the CHW and Counselor, "Ann Marie" is improving. She is setting goals and using coping skills learned during her sessions with Gin. She was prescribed medication for anxiety and high blood pressure. As she thrives with the services provided by OCFC, she continues with her sessions until she is ready to move on..."Ann Marie" expresses her thanks to everyone at the Clinic– from the front office to everyone who helped move her to feeling better!

Patients depend on the Clinic for so many reasons including their medications, chronic care and supplies, diagnostic screenings, mental health counseling, visits to our Clothes Closet and food pantry and more!

We do our very best to care for those who are medically underserved by providing coordinated care in a fully staffed environment. If not for the Orange County Free Clinic many would not be able to afford the holistic care that OCFC provides.

This is an exciting time for the Clinic because its' helping to fill a gap due to increased demand for services and the lack of affordable access to mental health professionals (even with health insurance) in our area.


