OCFC provides care for the "whole person" offering both mental and physical primary care all under one roof...The Orange County Free Clinic!

Mental Health Services at the OCFC are thriving and helping residents who would not have access to mental health care if not for the Clinic! We are celebrating a full year since we were able to hire a part-time Counselor with seed funds from the Culpeper Wellness Foundation, thus creating a new beginning for a more robust program and consistent availability for patients! The Clinic's Mental Health Counselor works closely with other OCFC providers to make sure patients have the best possible outcome. Our Counselor current-

ly works with 88 patients and continues to build on a growing waiting list.

OCFC primary care services,

including medications and critical supplies are free to qualified residents and we never ask for payment...OCFC is a vital resource to Orange County; so much so that other care providers, the VA Dept of Health and healthcare providers in our community look to the OCFC as a vital partner in addressing healthcare concerns in our area.

"We listened to his story...that's what we do..."Dorren Brown, OCFC Executive Director



Dorren shared this story with guests at our GALA and it is worth repeating.

Routinely answering the phone, Dorren answered to a lady who said she didn't know what to do. She had never reached out for help before and had heard about us. She

was worried about her 50 year old son and needed help!

He had just moved back to Orange to live with his brother after a divorce, lost his job and insurance. He is a severe insulin dependent diabetic and could not afford his medications. She paid for his medications last month and couldn't afford to buy it again this month. She was afraid he would die without help, and that her husband had died at 56 from the same illnesses. An appointment was made for her son the next day.

John Doe arrived with a bag of empty medicine bottles and Lisa (Office Mgr.) checked him in and enrolled him as a new patient. His story continued...he lost his job and insurance as a truck driver...he also used to volunteer with the Fire Department.

He told Lisa and Dorren that he no longer can afford his meds, and was so embarrassed to have to come here, knowing he never had to depend on assistance ever...

After Jeanie, our RN took his vitals, he met with Leslie, our Family Nurse Practitioner. Leslie saw him for a considerable amount of time and during his visit, she listened to his story and set up his plan of care...

He then met with Crystal, our Sr. MAP caseworker and was enrolled in the medication assistance program to get his diabetic mediations and hypertension meds. He told her before he came to us today, "he had about given up and decided to just let nature take its course, going without his medications he couldn't afford".

At check out, Dorren told him she was sorry his visit took so long and that we wanted to get everything in place for him! John told her "not at all," this was the first time he'd been anywhere when he didn't feel like a number. He said Nurse Leslie listened to him and gave him hope that he had not had in a very long time...he was so appreciative of that.

He left smiling with a supply of insulin and another appointment in 3 weeks...

...We listened to his story...that's what we do!!


